## "Private Harold Gay

News was received on Friday morning by the parents of Private Harold Gay, that their son had been killed in action in France on November 20<sup>th</sup> last. Private Gay belonged to 'W' Company of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion of the Northumberland Fusiliers, and was 20 years of age. He enlisted just over six months ago, prior to which he was employed at the Kiveton Park Colliery. Pte. Gay lived at Firvale, two doors away from where Pte. George Wapplington, reported missing, resided. Much sympathy is expressed with Pte. Gay's parents in their sore trial."
