Last week we stated that the parents of Pte. Albert Arthur Smith had received information that he had been wounded in action in France. On Tuesday morning the official intimation was received that Pte. Albert Arthur Smith, 1st Battalion Grenadier Guards, had died on June 15th, of wounds received in action. Quite a gloom was cast over the village when the news leaked out, and the church bells tolled.

Pte. Smith was a fine manly young man and was of a most cheerful disposition. He was an ex-member of the choir of All Hallows Church and of the Rev. B. Darley's Bible Class. He enlisted on September 3rd 1914 and joined the Grenadier Guards.

Much sympathy is extended by the parishioners to his parents and brothers and sisters and to his fiancée (Miss Heeley, of Sheffield). Pte. Smith would have attained his 23rd birthday on Monday last."
