Allen Joseph Featherstone, was born 13th July 1888. He married Annie Clark, age 24, daughter of William Marshall Clark, a miner from Waleswood. They married at Wales Church on 2nd November 1913, and at the time of Allen's death Annie was living at Woodall. They had one child Mabel, who was baptised by her mother at Harthill Church on the 9th September 1917, (14 months after her father's death). Allan enlisted into Lancashire Fusiliers, January 7th 1915, using his middle name Joseph.

Notification has been received from the War Office by Mrs. A. J. Featherstone of Woodall, that her husband, Private Alan Joseph Featherstone, 10th Battalion, Lancashire Fusiliers, was killed in action on July 14th. Pte., Featherstone had only been in France a fortnight, and he would have attained his 28th birthday, the day following that on which he was killed.

Previous to enlistment he was employed by the Kiveton Park Collieries. Much Sympathy is expressed to the widow and child.
